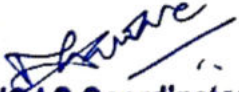

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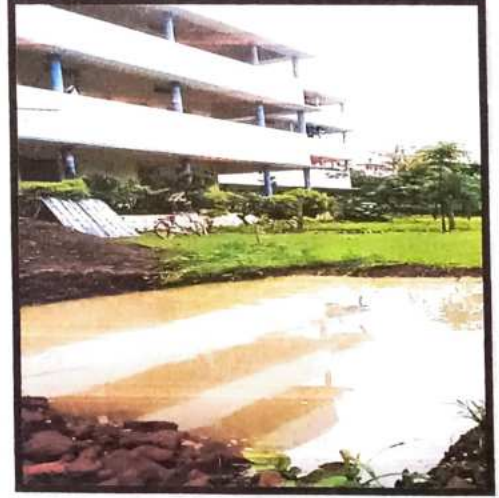

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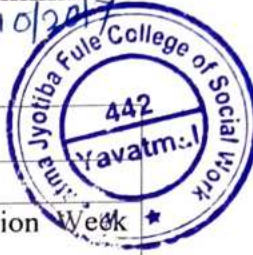

Objective	Being a social work college, we believe that it's our ethical responsibility to act in the situation of emergency and rekindle a ray of hope in order to rebuild the broken lives.
Brief Report	Mahatma Jyotiba Fule college of Social work, Yavatmal, Maharashtra. In response to Kerala flood, our college of social work has been formed team Nirmaan Kerala – a group of 50 Professional (Male-27, Female-23) social work students and some of NGOs highly sensitized representatives in Yavatmal. We started our journey on 30th of August and reached at Ernakulum on 1st September, we worked for almost 10 days. We were coordinated with the local administration of Ernakulum and kakkanad districts we divided our team into 2 -3 groups as per situation. We had also joined the other relief work groups over there. In this divesting flood situation in the state of Kerala, the students along with our faculty members namely Prof. Ratndip Gangale, Prof. Anil Deshmukh, Prof. Rahul Gondane and are joining hands for the relief work. The team had been work at Kerala from August 30, 2018 for almost 10 days. 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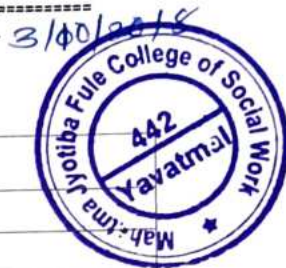

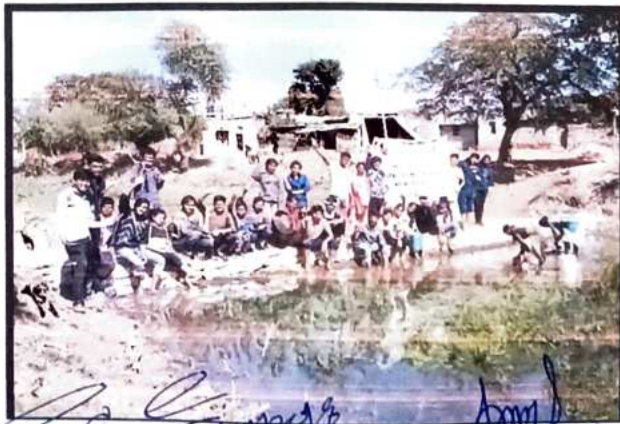
Brief Report

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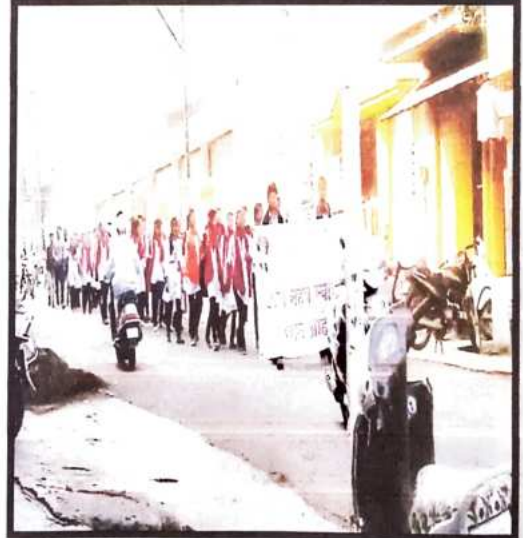

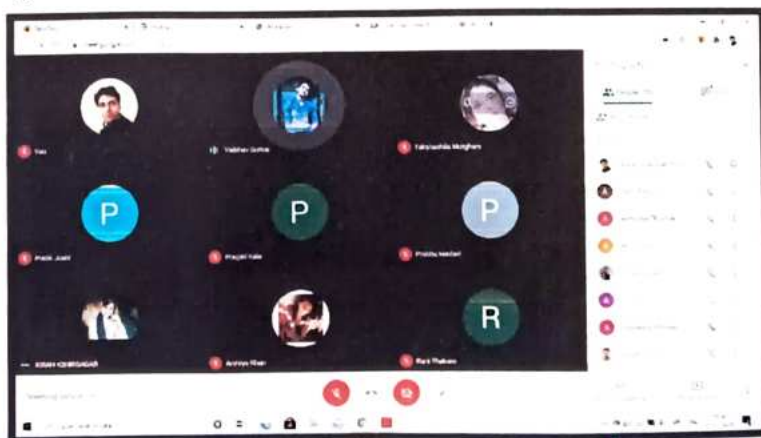
Brief Report

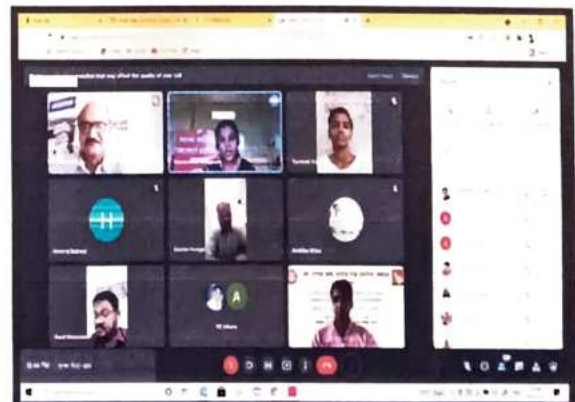
