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Mahatma Jyotiba Fule College of Social Work, Yavatmal, As the college provides professional social work education through imparting 3 year Bachelors in Social Work (BSW), 2 year Masters in Social Work (MSW) programs and Ph.D. in Social Work.

Whereas, the KEM Hospital Research Centre and KEM Hospital are leading institutions working with a commitment towards equitable health for all – in urban and rural areas in and around Pune and other neighbouring districts. Alongside the medical service component of the hospital the KEM Hospital Research Centre (KEMHRC) addresses clinical and social science research, training and vocational interventions aimed at improving the lives, livelihoods and lifestyles of the population - the main determinant of the health of a society. The institutional capabilities of the Hospital and Research Centre (1972) over the years have advanced from research in the medical field on topics intimately related to population control, health, hygiene and maternal and child health to embrace a horizontal approach in health care delivery in not only reproductive health (RCH) but also Psychiatry, sociocultural research, sexology and prevention of sexual abuse, thus striving towards optimal health and well-being of the community.

KEMHRC is engaged in research addressing Reproductive and Child Health (RCH), adolescent health, HIV and AIDS, quality of health services, women's development and various clinical topics. This is a multiple disciplinary approach which leads to providing quality services at the KEM Hospital and inform policy makers regarding evidence-based interventions. Many exploratory and interventional studies are undertaken which were funded by ICMR, Ford Foundation, USAID, IMPACT Foundation UK, Population Council New York, Government of India etc. Each project has to be approved by the Ethics Committee, before work begins on the project. This novel scientific treatment approach has been culturally adapted from the German program, Project Dunkelfeld to suit the Indian sociocultural and legal contexts. Various awareness and training activities and conferences are being carried out to sensitise the community, health care professionals and social workers towards the issue of paedophilia.

Research in Internal Medicine, Paediatrics, Gynaecology, Diabetes, Cardiology, Psychiatry, Gastroenterology, ENT, Oncology, Pulmonology, and ICU form part of the multi-centric clinical trials in the Research Centre. Inter-sectoral co-ordination and co-

However, the ownership of data would remain with the institution from where the data are collected, with other institution being the custodian of the data with equal rights to use the data responsibly. Even if one party is owner and other is custodian of the data, both parties would use data with mutual consent.

Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The Arbitral Tribunal shall consist of a sole arbitrator, to be appointed mutually by both the parties. The venue of arbitration shall be Pune. The language of arbitration shall be English. The Award of the Tribunal shall be final and binding on the parties.

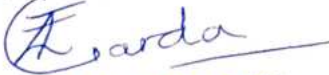

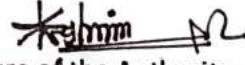

This MoU Will be valid for Three year i.e., 5 March 2021- 4 March 2024

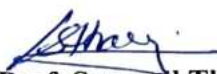
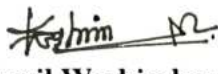
